In the midst of the Burials there are two half-obliterated marriage entries as follows:-

....., was married to Bridgett Dowdell

....., was married to Katherine Snelgrove

7th July - Charles Ashe a'Court, Esq., & Mary Elizabeth Catherine Gibbs, having been married at Palermo in Sicily, 8with all the formality which circumstances permitted, and the same duly attested, yet to remove every shade of doubt, if any such exist, from any constitution, were married in this church by licence.

A marginal note reads:- *the Certificate of the said marriage, duly attested, a duplicate of which is registered in the Bishop of London's office, in Doctor's Commons is hereto affixed.
