In the early part of this month, as Mr. Barret, a respectable farmer, of Wanborough, Wilts, being on a visit to Mr. Pinnegar, of Round Robin farm, in Highworth parish, was shewing how his mare could leap, and standing too near her heels, with a short whip, with which he struck her, she flung herself out with great violence, and kicking him in the left side, killed him on the spot. *Sporting Magazine* 1809, Volume 33, Page 147, December 1808
