## Civil War in Highworth

Saturday, 28th June 1645

This day we understood by Letters from the Army that Sir Thomas Fairfax was marching forwards for the relief at Taunton and that in his passage he had taken a garrison of the enemies, which did much annoy the country, called Highworth Church; that a Lieutenant Colonel of the Kings and some others were killed and about 60 prisoners taken, with store of Arms and Provisions.
