Committed to the New Prison, Devizes. Henry Lewis of Hilmarton and John Strange of Bremhill for three weeks for leaving their families chargeable to their respective parishes.

Attempted Suicide The village blacksmith here, name Downham inflicted a fearful gash across his throat yesterday morning, laying bare the windpipe. There is little hope of his recovery; he is, however, under the care of Dr. Campbell of Calne, who is doing all that is possible to save his life. **Wiltshire Independent, 30 April 1874**
