Yachting Jacket Stolen

Stolen from a stable at Littlecott Farm Hilmarton, on 17th Instant:- a dark mixture cloth yachting Jacket, pockets at sides, the lining of one sleeve torn has 'Yachting' stamped on loop of collar. Supposed by a Welshman, about 30 to 35 years of age, 5 feet 5 inches high, dark hair and whiskers black stubby moustache, blind of one eye, supposed right, round full face, rather stout build, a labourer; dressed in cloth cap, with peak, fustian trousers, and supposed stolen jacket. Information to Mr. Supt. Barrett, Chippenham, Wilts.
