1828

Committed to the House of Correction, Devizes Thomas Field, of Chippenham, James Norris of Hilperton, James Strange, of Corsham, John Garrett, of Warminster, and Benjamin Woods, of Codford St. Mary, for three months each, for breaches of the Game Laws. Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Monday, 21 January 1828

1846

For Trial. William James Merrett, charged with stealing a quantity of potatoes, the property of James Swaine at Hilperton. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette, 19 March 1846**

1888

Bradford on Avon. In the police court, for a similar offence [previous cases were for trespass] at Great Chalfield, on the 24th inst., Walter and Herbert Hodge, brothers, of Hilperton, were fined £1 each, to include costs. The Bristol Mercury, Friday, 30 November 1888

1890

Samuel Rich, of Hilperton, was also fined 14s for a like offence [being drunk] on May 26th.
