| Sergeant Albert William Phillips was one of 5 British Soldiers who are remembered in "Memorial Row" – "To the memory of these five British Soldiers, who fell in 1914, and were buried by the enemy in Weidendreft German Cemetery, Langemarck, but whose graves are now lost". "Their glory shall not be bottled out". | |
