Arthur's parents had married in 1883 in St. John the Baptist Church, Hindon, Wiltshire.	
Arthur Frank Stevens served with 10 th Hussars as a Private with a service number of 19812 & as a Shoeing Smith with a service number of 17410. He also served with Machine Gun Corps (Cavalry) - 8 th Squadron with a service number of 51250.	
The 8 th Squadron Machine Gun Corps (Cavalry) was formed 29 February 1916 for 8th Cavalry Brigade in 3rd Cavalry Division. Machine gun sections taken from Royal Horse Guards, 10th Hussars and Essex Yeomanry. They moved to 7th Cavalry Brigade 11 March 1918.
