<p>Oliver Snook(e) was born at East Knoyle in 1892 to parents Edward Wilberforce Snook &amp; Alice Mary Snook née Barnard). His birth was registered in the district of Mere, Wiltshire in the December quarter of 1892. Oliver's parents had married at Wells, Somerset in 1891.</p>	
<p>From the Supplement to the London Gazette Tuesday 22 August, 1916:  War Office 23<sup>rd</sup> August, 1916  His Majesty the KING has been graciously pleased to award the Military Medal for bravery in the field to the undermentioned Non-commissioned Officers and Men:-  5150 Cpl. O. Snooke, R. Fus.</p>	
<p>Wells Journal 8 September, 1916  Wookey  Sergt. Oliver Snooke, 12<sup>th</sup> Royal Fusiliers, has been awarded the Military Medal for conspicuous bravery in France. He is the eldest son of Mr and Mrs E. W. Snook, of Holloway, East Knoyle, and grandson of the late Mr Charles Barnard, of Wookey.</p>
