Other Significant Information	
Parents were married in St. John the Baptist Church, Hindon, Wiltshire in 1884	
Sidney George Phillips enlisted at Market House, Salisbury with Wiltshire Regiment on 6 th December, 1915. He was given the rank of Private & a service number of 23737. Sidney Phillips' Attestation Paper states he was aged 28 years & 10 months, from High Street, Hindon, Wiltshire. His occupation was Steersman (Traction Engine) & his next-of-kin was listed as his father – Mr William Phillips. His religion was Church of England.	
Pte Phillips embarked from Devonport on 18 th September, 1916 with Mediterranean Expeditionary Force & disembarked at Basra on 15 th October, 1916.
