Inquests held by G. Sylvester, Esq., and G. M. Sylvester, Esq (Deputy Coroner).

At Horningsham, on Wyndham Trollope, aged 23 years. The deceased was working in company with Alfred Turner, in a saw-pit, when a fall of sand took place of about three loads, covering the deceased to three feet above his head. Turner immediately called for assistance, and he was extricated in about a quarter of an hour, and found in an erect position, but the vital spark had fled. Verdict, "Accidental death from suffocation."
