



Estate of John Waite 1829 late Marylebone, London

John Waite, Deceased

ALL PERSONS claiming to be Children or Representatives of STEPHEN WAITE and THOMAS WAITE, and as such entitled under the Will of JOHN WAITE, the brother of the said STEPHEN and THOMAS WAITE, of No. 29, New Church-street, Marylebone, Pianoforte Manufacturer, who died in 1829, and all persons who can give information as to the said STEPHEN and THOMAS WAITE or as to STEPHEN WAITE, son of the first-named STEPHEN, are requested to communicate with Mr. Meek of Devizes, Solicitor. STEPHEN WAITE, the father, was baptised at Hewish, Wilts in 1766 and afterwards lived as a Farrier in London. His son STEPHEN died in Curhbert-street, Paddington, in 1849. THOMAS WAITE, a Carpenter, was baptised at Hewish in 1768, and is supposed to have finally left that place about 50 years ago.
