Hullavington



HULLAVINGTON is a village in the Chippenham Division of Wilts, Union, Petty Sessional Division and County Court District of Malmesbury, and Diocese of Bristol, and is distant 5 miles from Malmesbury and 7 from Chippenham. The register of the Church of St. Mary dated from 1694. The living is a vicarage, net yearly value £200 with residence, in the gift of Eton College. There are Baptist, Congregational and Primitive Methodist Chapels. The principal landowners are Eton College and Lieut.-Col. Sir Audley D. Neeld, Bart. C.B., M.V.O. Area, 3,303 acres, rateable value, £4,080; population in 1921, 478. Letters arrive through Chippenham, and are despatched at 10.25 am. And 6.5 pm. The nearest Money Order Office is at Grittleton, but there is a Telegraph and Telephone Office at Hullavington.
