In the Name of God Amen I Anthony Bleek of Hullavington in the County of Wilts Yeoman being weak of Body but of perfect Memory this Twenty third day of November in the ninth yeare of his Majesties which is now over England Annoq Dom 1697do make and ordain this my Last will and Testament in Manner and form following that is to say

Imp I give my son John That money which is due unto mee from him on A Certain Bond of sixty pounds for the payment of Thirty of Lawfull English Money I give my daughter Mary ten shillings and I g Nathaniel Marsh and my Daughter Jone his wife one shilling apeece

Item I make ordain and Nominate my Grandson Anthony Bleek son of my said son John Bleek the sole and only Executor of this my Last will and Testament And I doe hereby make voyd All other and former Wills and Testaments by me formerly made and doe Ratifie and Confirm this to be my Last will and Testament

I Give Rober Brook Twenty Shillings I Give Mary Jacques Thirty shillings
