MANOR of IDMASTON, Wilts. WHEREAS the GAME of this Manor hath been of late years much poached and destroyed; this is to give notice, that all unqualified persons who are found sporting or trespassing therein, will be dealt with and punished according to law; and all qualified persons are requested to forbear sporting there, until the game is increased. If any person will give notice to **EDWARD TOWSEY**, Gamekeeper, of any unqualified person offending after this notice, such person shall be rewarded for so doing.
