I Eupham Gibbons of Imber in the County of Wilts Widow hereby revoking all others do hereby declare this to be my last Will and Testament first I will that all my just debts and funeral expences be paid and satisfied I give unto my Nieces Eliza Wastfield Balentine Wastfield and Eupham Snelgrove forty pounds each to my Nephews William Miskin Jacob Scammell Thomas Wastfield and James Miskin forty pounds each to Rose Miskin forty pounds and Eupham Whatley fifty pounds To

my Sister in law Frances Gibbons and to my niece Miss Ann Scammell fifty pounds each I give to Eupham Scammell daughter of Philip Scammell my nephew five pounds to be paid in twelve months after my decease I give to her my said Niece Miss Ann Scammell all my household goods furniture Clock and all my wearing apparel And as to all the rest residue and remainder of my Estate wearing apparel money effects and property whatsoever I give devise and bequeath the same and every part thereof unto my nephew Thomas Hayter his Executors Administrators and assigns and appoint him sole Executor of this my Will In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the twenty eighth day of November one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine \_ *Eupham Gibbons*
