Girling	Ella	<p>I, FRANCIS JOHN WRIGHT GIRLING M.A. Clerk in Holy Orders, have left the sum of One Hundred Pounds in memory of our darling Daughter, Ella, who entered into the Higher Life, Sept 26th, 1927 The interest of the money is to be used for the up-keep of the portion of the Church- yard of St. John the Baptist, Inglesham, which was consecrated by the Bishop of Bristol in 1922, on St. Michael and All Angels Day.
