1807

Game Destroyed Manors of Netheravon, Chisenbury-de-la-Folly, Fittleton, Hacklestone, Idmiston, Keevil, and Alton and Cholston, in the parish of Figheldean. Whereas the game on the aforesaid Manors has been most shamefully destroyed, particularly within the last two months, this is to request that all qualified persons will refrain from sporting thereon; and all unqualified persons seen sporting on the said Manors will be prosecuted with the utmost vigour of the law. 1827

Violent Assault and Robbery. Five men were apprehended at Trowbridge, under circumstances which justified a very strong suspicion of their having robbed and cruelly treated a man named Bailey of Keevil on Tuesday evening previous. Two of the men Richard Doggett and Moses Angell of Steeple Ashton were fully committed to Fisherton gaol for trial. **Jackson's Oxford Journal, 29 November**

1843

Wilts Epiphany Sessions George Guernsey, charged with having stolen an iron chain trace, the property of John Watts, the elder, at Keevil. Guilty: 3 months imprisonment & once whipped. **Wiltshire Independent, 12 January 1843**
