In the Name of God Amen I Robert Pope of the Parish of Keevil in the County of Wilts Yeoman being of sound mind and memory and understanding (praised be God) Do this twenty sixth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and seventy five make and declare this my last will and testament in manner following that is to say all my money, goods, chattels, rights, credits, plate, personal estate and effects of what nature or kind so ever the same be (after payment of my debts and funeral expences) I give and bequeath the same unto Margaret Williams whom I do hereby make and appoint sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament.
