And his Wife Mary Corp, Aged 91 Years Who were Inhabitants of this Parish For more than forty years.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">They died in Bath and are interred in this Churchyard</p> <p>Elizabeth Neat gives the sum of three hundred pounds to be invested for the Poor of this Parish, the interest to be divided Yearly in November between Ten poor aged men and ten women</p> <p>Also Thirty Pounds to be invested, the interest to be applied to keeping the Tombstone and Railing in Repair. Any surplus that may accumulate to be added to the sum paid to the poor.</p>
