## Kington St. Michael

SITUATED 3 miles from Chippenham, Kington St. Michael comprises the tithings of Kington St. Michael and Easton Piercy. It is in the Chippenham Division of Wilts, Chippenham Union, Petty Sessional Division and County Court District, and Diocese of Bristol. The register of the Church of St. Michael dates from 1563, and the living is a vicarage of the net yearly value of £270, including 8 acres of glebe, with residence, in the gift of the Bishop of Bristol. There is a Congregational Chapel. Col. Sir Audley Neeld, Bart., the late Major Coleman's Trustees and Mr. G. Malcolm Thompson are the chief landowners. Area, 2,430 acres; rateable value, £3,227; population 473. Letters arrive through Chippenham, and are despatched at 11 a.m. and 7 p.m. The nearest Telegraph Office is at Yatton Keynell. Postal orders are issued at Kington St. Michael.
