Norris	Thos.	For stealing a saw and other articles at Knook. <i>Outcome: 12 months imprisonment</i>	<i>Salisbury and Winchester Journal</i> Mon 13 March, 1820
Green	William	Of Knook, for stealing from the person of Joseph William Hinton, a silver watch, &c.	<i>Salisbury and Winchester Journal</i> Sat. 9 Dec., 1848
Bacon	George	Of Knook, for killing fish. <i>Outcome: 1 month imprisonment</i>	<i>Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette</i> Thurs 14 Feb., 1850
Horler	Thomas	For stealing a sickle, the property of Joseph Hook, at Knook. <i>Outcome: 1 month imprisonment</i>	<i>Salisbury and Winchester Journal</i> Sat. 19 Oct., 1850
Andrews	Job	For stealing four pigs, the property of Thomas Parham, at Knook. <i>Outcome: 6 months imprisonment</i>	<i>Salisbury and Winchester Journal</i> Sat. 13 March, 1852
Dicks	William	Charged with stealing a ewe sheep, the property of Mr Richard Sydenham Wills, at Knooke. <i>Outcome: 4 months imprisonment</i>	<i>Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette</i> Thurs 5 Jan., 1860
Williams	Jane	10 year old girl, prosecuted by her father – Charles Williams for stealing a cotton sheet, a canvas bag & a pair of trousers. <i>Outcome: 14 days imprisonment</i>	<i>Wiltshire Independent</i> Thurs 10 Feb., 1870
