Inquests taken before G. Sylvester, esq.

At Knook, on Alfred Andrews, aged two years. The deceased was playing with another child on the bank of the river Wylie, and fell into it; his mother jumped in to rescue him, and would have been drowned also if assistance had not been rendered. The child was taken out in an insensible state, and means of resuscitation used in vain.

Verdict – Accidentally drowned.
