John Whatley March, 1860

Inquests taken before Mr Geo. Sylvester, Esq. -

At Knook, on John Whatley, aged six months. This infant was apparently in the best health, but died instantaneously, being suffocated from spasm of the glottis or upper part of the windpipe.

Verdict – "Visitation of God."
