Joshua Baron February, 1858

Inquests held by George Sylvester, esq.

At Knook, on Joshua Baron, aged five years. The deceased was left in the house with a younger sister, his clothes became ignited, and were consumed, inflicting such severe injuries as to cause death in a few hours.

Verdict - "Accidental death."
