### **BAKERS FINED**

On Tuesday the 28<sup>th</sup> of last month William Churchill of Corton, William Withers of Corton, Obadiah Green of Knook, Joseph Mold of Codford St. Mary, and Thomas Wickham of Wiley, all bakers, were convicted in mitigated penalties of £5 each before Harry Biggs, Esq. one of his Majesty's Justices of the Peace for the county of Wilts, for having short weights, and using alum and other ingredients in their bread prohibited by Act of Parliament.
