


Knook

The days of heavy draughts of fishes are not over. A portion of the river Wylye, near Knook, Wilts, over which Lord Heytesbury has the right of fishing, was last week dragged, when an enormous quantity of fish was found. The number caught at one draught, including chiefly roach and perch, was 2,900.
