**KNOOK** (*ST. MARGARET*), a parish, in the union of Warminster, hundred of Heytesbury, Warminster and S. division of Wilts, 1 mile (E.S.E.) from Heytesbury; containing 255 inhabitants. It is situated on the road from Bath to Salisbury. The living is a perpetual curacy, usually held with that of Heytesbury; net value £60; patron, the Dean of Salisbury. The tithes were commuted for land and a money payment, under an act of inclosure, in 1792.
