## **Boundary Post**

### **Opposite Junction with B390 (to Chitterne)**

A36 & B390 Junction, Knook, Wiltshire

Grade II - Listed 1<sup>st</sup> July, 1986

Boundary post. 1840.

Cast-iron T-shaped post with low pedimented top.

Lettering; HEYTESBURY on right arm, KNOOK on left arm.

C & MW/1840 on top of post, representing Carson and Miller a firm of Warminster ironfounders. One of a series of boundary posts and cast-iron milestones erected 1840 on Warminster radial turnpike roads. (R. Haynes, *Milestones in Leisure in Wiltshire*, 1968.)
