At Lacock, on the body of the female child of Charles Pegler, labourer, which died soon after birth, without medical attendance.

Mr. Crisp, the surgeon, was called in to examine the body, and being of opinion that the child died from natural causes, the jury returned a verdict in accordance with his testimony.
