John Leonard Smith (27) in service as a butler at Seend House, Seend, Wilts, and Richard George Moore (19), kitchen boy also of Seend, pleaded guilty at the Bristol Assize yesterday, before Mr Justice Wright, to breaking and entering a store of the Working Men's Club at Lacock, Wilts, on the night of October 28-29 1920, and stealing £3 1s 9½d and 15 packets of cigarettes, the property of the club.

Mr Justice Wright said both had had good characters previously. It was a curious case. They seemed to have suddenly entered upon a system of breaking and entering into places. They would be sent to prison for one month in each case.
