In the Name of God Amen The seconde daie of Aprill in the three and thirtithe yeere of the raigne of oure Sovereigne Ladie Elizabeth by the grace of God of Englande ffrance and Irelande Queene Defender of the faithe I Richarde Inckpen of Bedwin Parva in the Countie of Wiltes beinge sicke in bodie but perfecte in minde thanks be to god thearfore doe make this my last will and testamente in manner and forme followinge viz ffirst I give and bequeathe my soule into the handes of all mightie god and my bodie to be in the churche of Bedwin aforesaid Item I give and bequeath to Adrian Inckpen one hundred poundes Item I cancell all former giftes given to Nicholas Inckpen in consideration whearof I give him one hundred poundes Item I give to my brother Robert Blake fiftie poundes Item I give to Marie Blake fiftie poundes Item I give to Margaret Blake fiftie poundes the residue of all my goods not given nor bequeathed I give and bequeath to my brother Robert Blake whome I make my whole Exequitor in the presence of us whose names are underwritten *Richard Blake* \_ *Richard Claye* vicar \_ *Thomas Heyes* \_ *Willm Clines* Agnes .....fforde with others in pnsence of me *William Clines* Scriptorem
