Marriage On the 12th inst., at All Saint's, Herstmoncoux, Sussex, by the Rev. C. S. Harington, brother of the bride, assisted by Rev. G. B. Barker, George Brown, esq., eldest son of George Brown, esq., of Avebury, Wilts, to Emily Sophia, eldest daughter of the late Rev. 1861

Death July 26, at Agra, of cholera, aged 28. Captain Hastings Edward Harrington, H.M.'s Indian Artillery, V.C., third son of the late Rev. John Harrington, rector of Little Hinton, Wilts. **The Swindon Advertiser, 16 September 1861**

1864

Death **SUDDEN DEATH** On Thursday last, whilst a labouring man names William Willis was engaged in decorating the parish church, in celebration of Christmas, he suddenly expired. We understand he was subject to fits. **The Swindon Advertiser, 26 December 1864**

1866

Death On the 22nd inst., at he the Grove, Little Hinton, Elizabeth, relict of the late Stephen Brown, Esq., Wye House, Marlborough, and eldest daughter of the late John Brown, Esq., Avebury, aged 76 years. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, 28 July 1866**

1867

Birth July 1, at Little Hinton, the wife of Mr. Ford, of a son. **The Swindon Advertiser, 8 July 1867**

1877

February 18, at Little Hinton, Miss Charlotte Pope, aged 87 years. **Swindon Evening Advertiser, 26 February 1877**

1889

Death The Rev. John Smith, rector of Little Hinton, near Shrivenham, did on the 18th inst. He was ordained in 1842, and had held the living of Little Hinton, which is in the patronage of the Bishop of Gloucester and Bristol, since 1858. **Gloucestershire Chronicle, 31 August 1889**

1892

Death January 13, at Little Hinton Rectory, Wilts, Katherine Maud Richards, wife of the Rev. R. E. Richards, aged 45. **Gloucestershire Chronicle, 23 January 1892**

1894

Marriage June 6, at Bishopstone, by the Rev. H. Ault, W. H. Saunders, of Little Hinton, to E. L. Povey, second daughter of Mr. John Povey, of Bishopstone. **Swindon Advertiser and North Wilts Chronicle, 9 June 1894**
