



Little Somerford 1800-1849

1832

Died On Friday last, at Somerford, Mr. Matthew Heath, aged 83; and on Saturday, his sister, Mrs. Shipton, aged 8. Mrs. S. had given orders for the funeral of her brother; was suddenly taken ill and expired. Their remains were yesterday interred in one grave. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette, 8 March 1832** [OPC Note:- Possibly Great Somerford or Somerford Keynes]
