Also of THOMAS HUNT, Son of the above STEPHEN and JANE HUNT who died in his Infancy. Also of JANE HUNT, Daughter of STEPHEN and MARY HUNT and Granddaughter of the above who died March 29th 1810. Aged 4 Years. MARY HUNT, the beloved Wife of STEPHEN HUNT died April 22nd 1842, in the 74th Year of her Age. STEPHEN HUNT died May 9th 1854, Aged 90 Years.</p>

Alfo of WILLIAM SHOARE Son of the above named John and Mary Shoare who departed this Life March 21st 1789. Aged 32 Years. By whofe Direction this Tablet was erected</p>
Shoare	Jane	<p>Underneath lie the Remains of JANE SHOARE first Wife of JOHN SHOARE, buried March the 9th 1749 And the Remains of JOHN SHOARE Son of the above named JOHN and JANE SHOARE, who died December the 3rd 1771, Aged 27 Years This Tablet is erected by the surviving Daughter of the first named JOHN and JANE SHOARE, as a Tribute of Respect to the Memory of an affectionate Mother and beloved Brother.</p>

Thynne	Thomas	<p style="text-align: center;">Sacred to the Memory of the Most Honorable THOMAS MARQUESS of BATH VISCOUNT WEYMOUTH BARON THYNNE of Warminster KNIGHT of the Most Noble Order of the GARTER</p> <p style="text-align: center;">This much respected Nobleman served their Majesties in the following high and honorable employment As one of the Lords of the Bedchamber to the King from the Year 1760-1763</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Master of the House to the Queen from 1763 to 1765 one of His Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State from Jan. 20th 1768 to Dec. 19th 1770 and again from Nov. 10th 1775 to Nov. 14th 1779</p> <p style="text-align: center;">and as Groom of the Stole from 1782 until his death. Elected A Knight of the Garter 1778, and created A Marquess 1789. He was born September the 24th 1734. succeeded his Father VISCOUNT WEYMOUTH Jan. 1750 and married May 22nd 1759 ELIZABETH CAVENDISH BENTINCK Daughter of WILLIAM DUKE of PORTLAND</p> <p style="text-align: center;">by who he had five Sons and ten Daughters of which number three Sons and five Daughters survived him. He died the 19th of November 1796.</p>
Webb	Michael	<p style="text-align: center;">In Memory of MICHAEL WEBB Gent. Who died July 10th 1788 Aged 71 Years. And lies interred on the other side of the middle Isle. ELIZABETH MASSEY his Daughter died 11th November 1794 Aged 45 Years. CHARLES WEBB his Son died 15th January 1808 Aged 49 Years.</p>
Wyche	Richard Samuel	<p style="text-align: center;">Sacred to the Memory of RICHARD SAMUEL WYCHE who died January 11th 1790, Aged 67 Years. Also MARY his Wife who died July 3rd 1801, Aged 76 Also of ANN WEBB Sister of the above MARY WYCHE who died December 6th 1813 Aged 87 Also of EDWARD BUTT, who died January 2nd 1850. Aged 65 Years Also of MARY ANN WYCHE, who died March 13th 1852, Aged 88 Years.</p>
