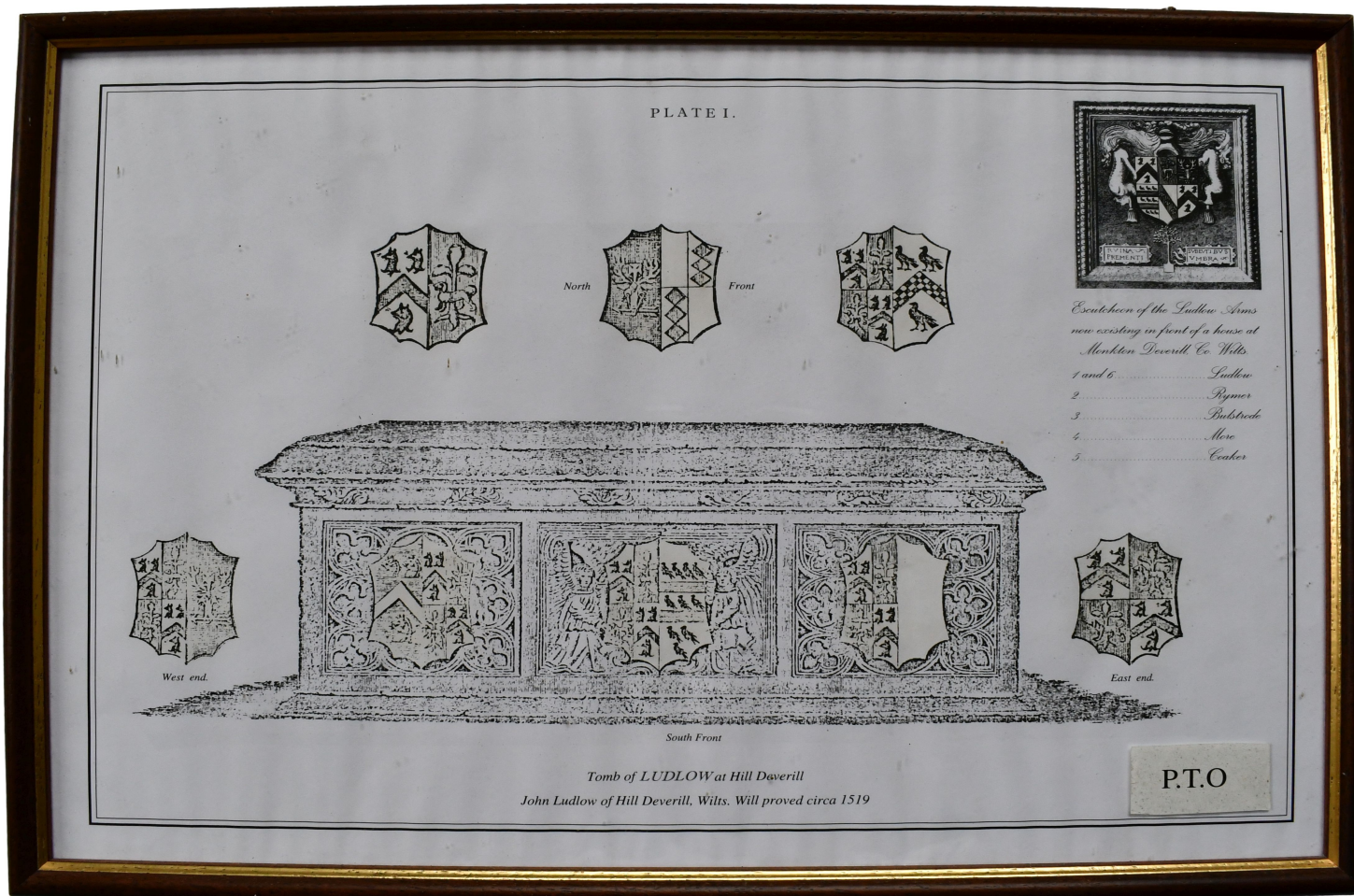


Longbridge Deverill

QUARTERLY COAT AND CREST, FROM THE VISITATION OF WILTS 1565. AS CERTIFIED AT THE COLLEGE OF ARMS.

BLAZON.

Quarterly 1st, LUDLOW: Argent, a chevron between three martlets argent, gules erased sable.
 2nd, RYMER: Or, in front of an oak tree embossed Or, a greyhound passant argent, gorged with a collar sable, studded of the second.
 3rd, BULSTRODE: Sable, a stag's head cabossed argent, between the antlers Or, a cross of the last, placed above the nostrils by an arrow in fess, point to the sinister; also gold feathers of the same; the nostrils drooping inward proper.
 4th, MOORE: Argent, two bars azure, between ten martlets, 4, 3, and 2, gules.
 CREST: A dam martlet couped sable.

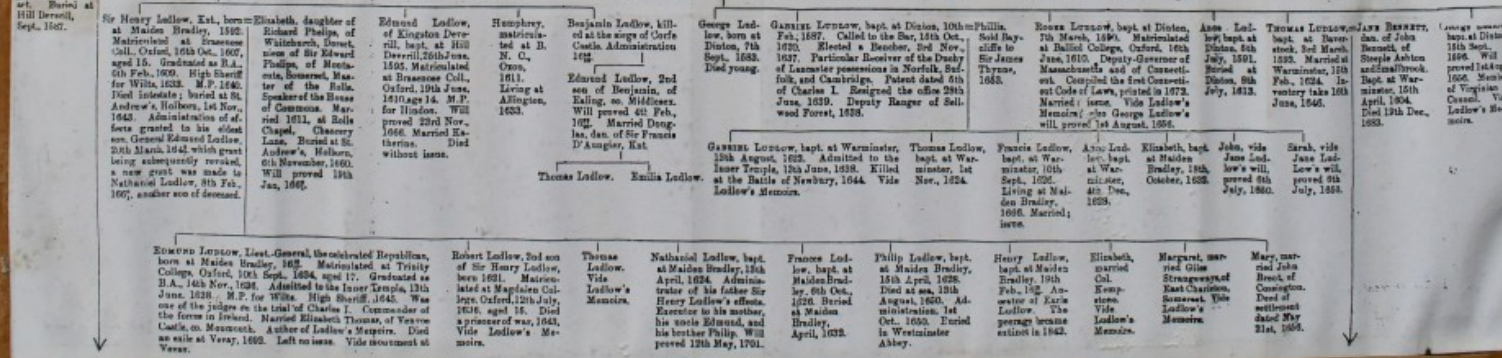
