

Swindon & District Directory Extract 1928 Luckington



LUCKINGTON is a parish in the Chippenham Division of Wilts, Union, Petty Sessional Division and County Court District of Malmesbury, and Diocese of Bristol, and is distant 3 miles from Badminton, 7½ from Malmesbury and 10 from Chippenham. The register of the Church dates from 1573, and the living, a rectory, with residence, is in the gift of Col. G. F. Ottley. The principle landowner is the Duke of Beaufort. Area, 1,585 acres; rateable value, £2,510; population in 1921, 293. Letters arrive from Chippenham, and the nearest Money Order and Telegraph Office is at Sherston, 2 miles distant.
