Salisbury Assizes. John Whale was indicted for having stolen one wether sheep, the property of Richard Lawrence, at Lineham. The Jury found the prisoner Guilty. Judgement of Death recorded. Salisbury and Winchester Journal, 14 March 1831

OPC Note: John Whale was transported to New South Wales on the "Surrey", on 15 July 1831.
