Lyneham and Bradenstoke

LYNEHAM is in the Chippenham Division of Wilts, Cricklade and Wootton Bassett Union, Cricklade Petty Sessional Division, Calne County Court District, and Diocese of Salisbury; and is 2 miles from Dauntsey Station, 4 from Wootton Bassett and 5 from Calne. The register of the Church of St. Michael dates from 1653. The living of Lyneham and Bradenstoke are now amalgamated, and are in the gift alternatively of the Bishop of Salisbury and Lieut.-Col. Heaneage. A school with an endowment of about £60 per annum (one fourth of which goes to Bradenstoke School), is situated at Church End. Area, 3,456 acres; rateable value, £6,234; population in 1921, 836. There are Baptist and Primitive Methodist Chapels at Bradenstoke, and Primitive Methodist Chapels in the hamlets of West Tockenham and Preston. Letters through Chippenham. The post box at Church End (Lyneham) is closed at 8.15 a.m. and 6 p.m. Lyneham Office at 12 noon and 6.10 p.m., and Bradenstoke at 6.30 p.m. A pillar box is cleared at Preston at 8.5 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. Letters for West Tockenham (a tithing) are received through Swindon. A Money Order, Savings Bank and Telegraph Office is now open at Bradenstoke, and a morning mail is despatched at 12.15. West Tockenham letters through Swindon.

BRADENSTOKE is a hamlet at the western extremity of Lyneham, having been formed in 1860 out of the parishes of Christian Malford and Lyneham for ecclesiastical purposes. The Gothic Church built by the late Sir G. Goldney, Bart., at Bradenstoke is dedicated to St. Mary the Virgin, the living being a vicarage of the annual value of £300. A school and school house were erected here in 1862 by voluntary subscription.
