

Parish Relief Order for Militia Substitute Robert Newman of Malmesbury Serving for Joseph Butler Hanks

Borough of Malmesbury

To Wit.: To the Overseers of the Poor of the Parish of Malmesbury in the said County of Borough Whereas it appears to me, one of His Majesty's Justices of the Peace in and for the County of said Borough aforesaid, that Robert Newman of Wilts. And is now in actual Service, and that the said Robert Newman hath left Mary his Wife and one Children born in Wedlock, and under the age of ten Years, now dwelling in the said Parish of Malmesbury who are unable to support themselves And whereas it also appears unto me, that the said Robert Newman serves as Substitute in the said Supplementary first Militia for Joseph Butler Hanks of the Parish of Malmesbury aforesaid in the County of

Now, by Virtue of an Act of Parliament made and passed in the thirty ninth Year of the Reign of his present Majesty King George the Third, to provide for the Families of Persons chosen by Lot to serve in the Militia of this Kingdom, and of Substitutes serving therein, I do hereby order you the Overseers of the Poor of the Said Parish of **Malmesbury** to pay unto **Mary Newman** Wife of the said **Robert Newman** the sum of **Two Shillings** weekly, and every week, for and towards the necessary Relief and Maintenance of the said **Mary Newman** Wife of the said **Robert Newman** and her said Children, during so long as the said **Robert Newman** shall be a Substitute in actual Service in the said Militia, or until you shall be otherwise ordered herein. Given under my Hand and Seal this **fourth** Day of **May 1798**
