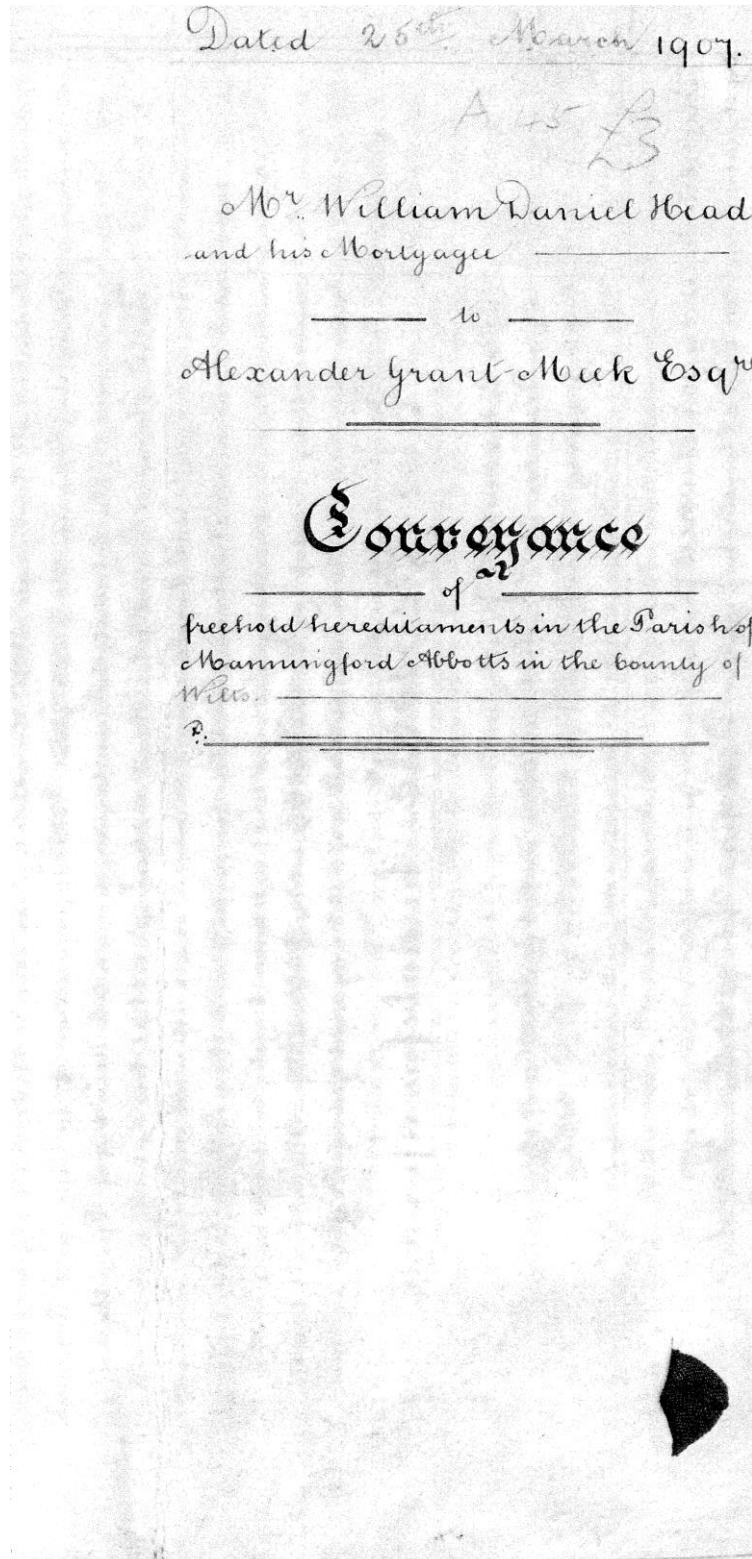


Manningford Abbas

Conveyance Of Land Between William Daniel Head to Alexander
Grant Meek dated 25 March 1907





This Indenture

made the twenty fifth day
of March One thousand
nine hundred and seven
Between Diana

Elizabeth Ford Wife of Robert Frederick Ford formerly of Sherwell in the Parish
of Seury in the County of Wilts & Miller but now of Bottlesford in the Parish of North
Newton in the said County borne Merchant of the first part William Daniel
Head of Manningford Bruce in the said County of Wilts Farmer of the second
part Alexander Grant Meeke of Hillworth House Deinyon in the said
County of Wilts Esquire of the third part and David John Head of Hossa
Mill butne in the said County of Wilts Mill barter of the fourth part **Whereas**
by an Indenture bearing date the twenty fourth day of December One thousand eight
hundred and seventy four and expressed to be made between David Head (since deceased)
of the one part and Diana Wells of the other part the hereditaments hereinafter described
and expressed to be hereby conveyed were (with other hereditaments) conveyed unto and
to the use of the said Diana Wells her heirs and assigns by way of Mortgage for
receiving the repayment of a sum of Four hundred pounds with interest thereon on a
day therein mentioned and since past **And whereas** by an Indenture bearing date
the thirty first day of January One thousand eight hundred and ninety five and
expressed to be made between the said Diana Wells of the one part and the said Diana
Wells and Diana Elizabeth Ford of the other part the sum of Three hundred pounds
then remaining due on the security of the last hereinafore recited Indenture and all
interest thereon to become due in respect of the same and the full benefit of all
securities for the same were assigned to the said Diana Wells and Diana Elizabeth
Ford and by the same Indenture the said hereditaments hereinafter described and
expressed to be hereby conveyed were conveyed unto and to the use of the said Diana
Wells and Diana Elizabeth Ford their heirs and assigns subject to such right or
equity of redemption as was then subsisting therein by virtue of the hereinafore
recited Indenture of the twenty fourth day of December One thousand eight
hundred and seventy four **And whereas** the said Diana Wells died on or
about the tenth day of June One thousand eight hundred and ninety five **And**
whereas the said David Head duly made his last Will and Testament bearing
date the twentieth day of July One thousand nine hundred and one and thereby
devised the hereditaments hereinafter described and expressed to be hereby
conveyed by the description of "the piece of land now fenced in and laid
down to pasture containing five acres and a quarter situate at Manningford
Abbots in the said County" to his Son the said William Daniel Head (in the
said Will called Daniel William) his heirs and assigns subject nevertheless
and charged with the payment of the sum of One hundred and sixty pounds
part of the said Mortgage debt of Three hundred pounds then due to the said
Diana Elizabeth Ford (in the said Will called Mrs. Robert Ford) and he
appointed his two Sons the said William Daniel Head and David John Head
joint Executors of his said Will **And whereas** the said David Head died
on or about the second day of February One thousand nine hundred and six
without having revoked or altered his said Will and the same was on the
twenty third day of March One thousand nine hundred and six duly
proved in the Salisbury District Registry of the Probate Division of the

High Court of Justice by the said William Daniel Head to the said David John Head the other Executor having renounced the Probate and execution thereof **And whereas** the sum of Three hundred pounds is still remains due and owing upon the security of the hereinafore recited Indenture of Mortgage but all interest thereon has been paid up to the date of these presents as she the said Diana Elizabeth Ford doth hereby acknowledge

And whereas the said William Daniel Head as such Executor as aforesaid has assented to the devise hereinafore recited as he doth hereby declare

And whereas the said William Daniel Head has agreed with the said Alexander Grant-Week for the sale to him of the said hereditaments at or for the price or sum of Two hundred and seventy pounds

And whereas it has been agreed that the sum of One hundred and sixty pounds part of the said purchase money shall be paid to the said Diana Elizabeth Ford in part discharge of the said Mortgage debt so due to her as aforesaid and that she shall concur in these presents in manner hereinafter appearing

Now this Indenture witnesseth that in pursuance of the said agreement and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and sixty pounds to the said Diana Elizabeth Ford paid by the said Alexander Grant-Week on or before the execution of these presents by the direction (hereby testified) of the said William Daniel Head in part discharge of the sum of Three hundred pounds so due to her as aforesaid (the receipt whereof the said Diana Elizabeth Ford doth hereby acknowledge) and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and ten pounds to the said William Daniel Head at the same time paid by the said Alexander Grant-Week (the payment and receipt in manner aforesaid of which said sums of One hundred and sixty pounds and One hundred and ten pounds making together the said sum of Two hundred and seventy pounds the said William Daniel Head doth hereby acknowledge) She the said Diana Elizabeth Ford as Mortgagee by the direction of the said William Daniel Head doth hereby convey and the said William Daniel Head as Beneficial Owner doth hereby convey and confirm unto the said Alexander Grant-Week and his heirs

All that piece or parcel of land containing by admeasurement five acres and thirty six perches or thereabouts as now staked out being part of a field Number 34 on the Tithe Apportionment Map for the Parish of Manningford Abbots in the said County of Wilt bounded on the North by a further portion of the said field formerly belonging to Joseph Lott but now to Walter Lott on the East partly by a further portion of the said field formerly belonging to Thomas Jeeves but now to Robert Huntley and partly by a field formerly belonging to the Reverend Freeman Wilson but now to Aubrey William Freeman Wilson on the South by a footpath and by land of the said Alexander Grant-Week and on the West by an old road leading to Manningford Hill which said premises are more particularly delineated on the Map or Plan drawn on or annexed to these presents and are thereon coloured pink

To hold the same unto and to the use of the said Alexander Grant-Week in fee simple freed and discharged from all principal money and interest

secured by and from all claims and demands under the heretofore recited
 Indenture of Mortgage **And** the said Diana Elizabeth Ford hereby acknowledges
 the right of the said Alexander Grant & Co to production of the Deeds and Documents
 mentioned in the Schedule hereunder written, and to delivery of copies thereof
And the said David John Head to the intent that his liability under the
 undertaking next hereinafter contained shall not arise until the said Deeds
 and Documents shall come into his possession and then only in respect of
 such of them as shall so come into his possession hereby undertaken for the
 safe custody thereof **In witness** whereof the said parties to these presents
 have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first above written.
