<b>Arrival Date</b>	23 <sup>rd</sup> May 1856
<b>Vessel</b>	Robert Small
<b>Relatives in the Colony</b>	2 Bothers George & Stephen at Hunter River
<b>Remarks</b>	Simon travelled out to New South Wales as a single male, paying £1 for his passage.

**OPC Note:** Simon Osland, the base born son of Mary Osland (a single woman), had been baptised at North Newnton on 25<sup>th</sup> December 1822.
