<b>Native Place and County</b>	Manningford by Hume [Bohune], Wiltshire
<b>Parents</b>	James and Elizabeth Hawkins (both dead)
<b>Religion</b>	Church of England
<b>Ability to Read and Write</b>	Read
<b>State of Bodily Health, Strength and Probable Usefulness</b>	Good
<b>Arrival Date</b>	19 <sup>th</sup> October 1855
<b>Vessel</b>	Gilmore
<b>Relatives in the Colony</b>	A nephew William Alexander in Sydney
<b>Remarks</b>	William, who was a widower, travelled to New South Wales with his children Charles, Thomas, Alfred and Mary J, paying £11 for his passage.

**OPC Note:** William Hawkins, the son of James and Elizabeth Hawkins of Manningford Bohune, had been baptised at North Newnton on 11<sup>th</sup> December 1796.
