<b>Parents</b>	Richard and Mary Osland (Mother on board the Tory)

<b>Ability to Read and Write</b>	Neither
<b>State of Bodily Health, Strength and Probable Usefulness</b>	Good
<b>Arrival Date</b>	9 <sup>th</sup> April 1849
<b>Vessel</b>	Tory
<b>Relatives in the Colony</b>	None
<b>Remarks</b>	William travelled out to New South Wales with his mother (Mary) and siblings (Henry John and Ellen). Another brother (Tory) was born during the voyage. Richard Osland is incorrectly recorded as his father.

**OPC Note:** William Hawkins Osland, the son of Mary Osland (widow) was born in Manningford Bohune on 21 September 1846. His father was probably William Hawkins a widower also living in Manningford Bohune.
