OPC Note: On the 1851 census the father of Charles Bromham (Jeremiah) is recorded as being a visitor in the house of Sophia Huntley in Manningford Bruce. Also on board the Lloyd travelling out to New South Wales was the son of Sophia Huntley (William Huntley). Jeremiah had married Hannah Batt in 1853.
