Manningford Bruce, a township, small village and parish, in Swanborough Hundred, Pewsey Union, situated on the

The living is a rectory, in the diocese of Sarum, and the property of the incumbent, the Rev. Alexander Grant. The church is a specimen of very ancient architecture, with an apse, which is a rare appendage. John Grant Esq., is lord of the manor.

The area of the parish is 1,091 acres, and the population 275.

Here is a mixed National school for the education of the children of the inhabitants.

Wiltshire Avon, 10 miles east-by-south from Devizes, and 2 south-west from Pewsey.

Manningford Bohun forms part of the village.
