

Marlborough St. Mary

Interesting Entries In the Parish Registers 1610-1653

Following 2 Feb1610/1 "Joseph Priscil. Priscil, the wife of Water, same.". [This is an exact copy of what is written, but it is difficult to make it into any entry. It may be only the idle work of the scribe.]

2 Jul 1615 "Thomas, ye son of Roger Web." [Looks like a baptism or burial out of place.]

Following 16 Apr 1627 "Those of ye Mi[nis]ters names for ye Sattersday Lecture:- Mr. Hughes, Mr. Buyfield, Mr. Chambers, Mr. Prophet, Mr. Simkins, Mr. Norris, Mr. Clerk, Mr. Hounsell, Mr. Harrison, Mr. Taylor, Mr. Webb, Mr. Brown, and Mr. Burley."

[The next leaf is blank on the first side. On the other side is the following entry:-] "MEMORAND - That Walter Jones was made Choise of approved and sworne to have keepeing of this booke for the Registering herein all publicacons for marriages all birthes of Children and burialls of all sorts of people in the p'ish of St. Maryes in Marlebrough according to the Act lately made to that purpose. Chosen the 20th of September 1653, and sworne the 28th day of the same month. John Lawrence. Tho. Hunt. Will. Blisset."
