### Interesting Entries in the Parish Registers 1690-1783

#### A Strange Baptism

26th June 1690 Mary ye daugh. of Mr Jo. Bowing which he had with Liddiah his wife a stranger, was borne June 15th.

These marriages do not appear to be registered for 1707:-

Richard Parfict paid for being married to Sarah Pope of this Parish  
George Church paid for he and his wife  
Danuell Tomlins paid for he and his wife  
William Hill paid for his deus for his wife

1727 An entry of the Baptism of the daughter of John and Mary Kemm is here interplated, then a Baptism has been entered and struck out.

#### 20 Apr 1730 to Mar 1730 - NOTE.-

The Entries from "John Tuck" to "Robart Iels" should, presumably, be in the year 1730, as printed here; but in the Registers they apparently follow, in irregular order, under the year 1729, and the year 1730 is inserted just before the following Entry.- 4 Apr 1730 Thomas Kate[r] & Elizabeth Canfield

1 Mar 1756 Thomas Brookes & Mary Brown. Marginal Note:- This marriage became null and void, the man having sworn himself to be of age when he was not, and therefore married again at No. 36, by the consent of his father. See entry of 7 Dec. 1756.

8 Jul 1767 John Strong & Susanna Deavin. The contracting parties did not apparently sign the Register, unless a signature in the body of the entry is intended for that of the woman the witness Deavin signed in the place of the man. Wit. Wm. Silk, Wm. Deavin.

Note.- The following should not have been registered here, see 3 leaves forward". [This is amongst the 1768 entries]

18 Jun 1770 John Bishop & Mary Paul, Lic.

18 Jun 1770 See John Bishop & Mary Paul, mar. by licence June 18, 1770, not registered here in course but 3 leaves back, in a void space left by mistake.

October 1st 1783. From this Day a Duty of 3d. is made payable to his Majesty for every Marriage by an Act of Parliament
