



Memorial Window for Alfred Henry Manders

A stained glass window has recently been erected in the north aisle of St. Mary's church, by Capt. and Mrs. Manders. The artistic arrangements are well conceived and appropriate. The window, which is by O'Connor, of London, had the following inscription: "In memory of Alfred Henry, eldest son of Captain Thomas Manders and Catharine, his wife. He was drowned off Erith, with nine other cadets of the officers' training ship Worcester, by the overturning of the ship's barge, in the 14th year of his age, on Tuesday, February 28th, 1865."

The minor lights have portraits of the lost lads.
