In the Name of God Amen I Elizabeth Barnes of Marlborough in the County of Wilts Widow being weak in Body but of sound mind and understanding doe make and Ordeyne this my last Will and Testament ffirst I ratifye and confirm unto my Nephew and Neece George Goldwyre of Marlborough and Elizabeth his Wife their Executors and Ass: all the Goods Chattles Estate and Effects mentioned and sold by me in and by one Deed Poll or Bill of Sale dated the twenty second day of August in the Yeare of our Lord one Thousand Seven Hundred Thirty and Eight Also I give and Bequeath unto the said George Goldwyre and Elizabeth his Wife All my Lands Tenements Hereditaments Goods Chattles and Personal Estate whatsoever which I shall be Seized possessed of or entitled unto at the time of my decease To hold unto the said George Goldwyre and Elizabeth his Wife for and as his her and their own Estate Goods and Chattles for ever (after all my Debts are fully paid and satisfied) Alsoe I nominate and appoint the said George Goldwyre and Elizabeth his Wife Executors of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoaking all former Wills by me at any time heretofore made and doe declare this and noe other to be my last Will and Testament In Testimony whereof I the said Elizabeth Barnes the

Testatrix have hereunto sett my hand and Seale this Eighth day of October in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Thirty Nine *Eliz: Barnes*
